The shares have no expiration date.
- 2. The Series A Preferred Stock is convertible into Common Stock on a 6.299-for-1 basis into the number of shares of Common Stock as shown in Column 3 without payment of further consideration, at any time at the holder's election and upon eithier the closing of a firm-commitment underwritten public offering pursuant to an effective registration statement resulting in at least \$60 million of gross proceeds to the Issuer, or the date and time or occurance of an event specified by at least 60% of the outstanding preferred stock. The shares have no expiration date.
- 3. The Series B Preferred Stock is convertible into Common Stock on a 6.299-for-1 basis into the number of shares of Common Stock as shown in Column 3 without payment of further consideration, at any time at the holder's election and upon eithier the closing of a firm-commitment underwritten public offering pursuant to an effective registration statement resulting in at least \$60 million of gross proceeds to the Issuer, or the date and time or occurance of an event specified by at least 60% of the outstanding preferred stock. The shares have no expiration date.
- 4. The reporting person is Vice President of Venture Capital of Pfizer, Inc., an affiliate of Pfizer Ventures (US) LLC. The reporting person disclaims beneficial ownership of such shares except to the extent of her pecuniary interest therein, if any, and this report shall not be deemed an admission that the reporting person is the beneficial owner of all of the reported shares for purposes of Section 16 or any other purpose.
